Would these projects be potentially eligible?

- The Facility will target projects that have the ability to generate a return, but not at a level sufficient to be 100 per cent financed by the private sector. The Commonwealth will assess all projects for financial viability before issuing a loan.
- **The Commonwealth will not lend to projects that are commercially viable without Government assistance**, to ensure that the Government is not crowding out the private sector.
 - Galilee Basin coal projects are likely to be commercially viable without Government assistance so would not be eligible
