## INFORMATION SHARING FOR SERIOUS FINANCIAL CRIME

### SUMMARY OF CONSULTATION PROCESS

The Government announced on 8 May 2015 that it would:

- allow taxation officers to continue to share taxpayer information with other Project Wickenby agencies, or a court or tribunal, until 30 June 2017; and
- allow taxation officers to share taxpayer information with other Fraud and Anti-Corruption Centre agencies on an ongoing basis.

This measure was included in *Taxation Administration Amendment (Disclosure of Information) Regulation 2015*, which was made under the authority of section 18 of the *Taxation Administration Act 1953*.

#### Consultation process

Consultation on the draft regulation was conducted between 8 May 2015 and 27 May 2015. Three submissions were received.
