

Process for determining remuneration of the Commonwealth Government CEOs

- The Australian Government Remuneration Tribunal determines the remuneration of the NDIA CEO.
- A review of remuneration can be requested.
 - To seek a review of remuneration, a submission requesting such a review and outlining reasons must be put to the Tribunal.
 - The Tribunal prefers to receive submissions from a Portfolio Minister, or a Secretary, Program Manager or Employing Body (in respect of a principal executive office - PEO) with responsibility for the relevant office(s).
 - Submissions can be put in at any time at which a submission can demonstrate significant changes or developments that affect the office. It should be noted, however, that the Tribunal is more likely to adjust remuneration for an existing office after any changes to that office have actually occurred and have had a demonstrable effect on the office's responsibilities and workload, rather than in anticipation of any changes.
 - The guidelines note that it is preferable to include an indication of support from the responsible Minister.
