Superannuation transparency

- The existing choice product dashboard and portfolio holdings disclosure requirements were introduced in 2012 by the Superannuation Legislation Amendment (Further MySuper and Transparency Measures) Act 2012, which requires:
- trustees of regulated superannuation funds with at least five members to publish a dashboard for each of the investment options within a fund's choice products; and
- information on all investments held by a registrable superannuation entity including both associated entities and non-associated entities to be disclosed.
- In April 2013, supporting regulations to the legislation were released for public consultation; however, the regulation was never made. ASIC Class Order [CO 14/443] delays the requirement to provide choice product dashboards until 1 July 2016.
