## **Response to FOI request 2350**

Net clearances of all tobacco products including cigarettes and loose leaf tobacco from the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) and the Department of Home Affairs (Home Affairs)\* for the period January 2017 - December 2017 inclusive. This represents an update of previous data published under FOI requests 1958 and 1970 and 2146.

\*Home Affairs was formed through combining two agencies: Customs and Border Protection and the Department of Immigration and Citizenship.

## **Tobacco: Sticks**

The data below have been provided to Treasury by the ATO and Home Affairs. They show net clearances of cigarettes (that is, after subtracting refunds which includes exports<sup>1</sup>) by month of payment for the ATO, and month of processing for Home Affairs.
