Industry Questionnaire: Sealed Bag Scheme Compliance Issues

To ensure the proposed regulations achieve their policy objective with a minimal compliance burden to industry, Treasury would appreciate affected businesses including a response to the following questions when returning a submission on the proposed regulation changes to the Sealed Bag Scheme.

The Sealed Bag Scheme: liquids, aerosols, gels, creams and pastes (LAGs)

- What will you need to do to implement the changes in your business?
- Will your businesses' current record keeping and reporting processes need to be amended to accommodate the changes and to include the new LAGs declaration?
- What changes will your businesses need to communicate to the Duty Free Security Company Staff?

- How will your business implement the LAGs' declaration? (Note: it can be provided as a separate declaration or combined invoice and declaration.)
- Would a LAGs-specific invoice which has the declaration incorporated in it be preferable to your business?
 - Would such a combined form make handling procedures easier, and lessen traveller confusion about what they need to do and what is being signed for?
 - What other impacts might there be?
- Would your business need to put in place new procedures to handle situations where the LAGs declaration is not presented, or the declaration is not signed, or would existing procedures for missed invoices cover these?
