NATIONAL BROADBAND NETWORK BILLS - REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

Timing: Urgent - your approval is required to permit the release of the Bills on 18 December 2009.

Issue: The Minister for Broadband, Communications and the Digital Economy has written seeking your approval (see letter at Attachment A) for:

- minor amendments to the *Trade Practices Act 1974* (TPA) reflecting new regulatory powers for the ACCC in relation to the National Broadband Network (NBN); and
- limits on the application of the *Corporations Act 2001* for the sale of the Government's stake in NBN Co.

Recommendation: That you sign the draft letter (at <u>Attachment B</u>) agreeing to the proposed amendments.

 - Amendments to sections 25 and 155 of the TPA will provide consistent application of the ability of the ACCC to delegate its powers and the ACCC's information gathering powers.
 - Proposed limits on the Corporations Act are consistent with legislation governing the sale of Telstra and Medibank Private.
 - : If agreed, the Minister for Financial Services, Superannuation and Corporate Law will notify the Ministerial Council for Corporations of the proposed clauses affecting the corporations legislation and circulate of a copy of the Bills to the Council in accordance with the *Corporations Agreement 2002*.
