I am a 457 Visa holder from the UK currently working in Perth WA. I am the main wage earner currently supporting my family (husband, and 3 children aged 2 years, 5 years and 13 years). I am not a high wage earner, and earn less than \$80k a year, as a temporary visa holder we are not entitled to any benefit assistance and the LAFHA currently helps to supplement my pay.

My husband is a stay at home dad as we cannot afford to place our youngest into full time day care and to also pay for before and after school care for our other 2 children. With the LAFHA now disappeARing this puts our family in a very difficult position financially, and with nowhere to turn have very few options.
