

SUBMISSION TO FSI ON CORPORATE CONDUCT

A DEMAND FOR COMMON DECENCY WITHIN THE BANKING & FINANCIAL COMMUNITY

In less than ten years' time, we're going to see major changes to our financial system whether its minders like it or not. They're inevitable, given the continued abuse of the system and the deafness and insensitivity of those responsible. The push for the bail-in is a good sign that the finance industry is more than aware of the fact. The present system has been so abused that it has nowhere to go but bust—as a result of lack of proper regulation. The responsibility for that rests with government, yes, but more so with the banking sector, which goaded government into compliance with their demands. I'm outraged that our weak-kneed political representatives allowed the abuse. As a sovereign Australian citizen, I demand the following:

1. That there be no bail-in of depositors in order to “save the banks”.

My grounds for objecting to this measure is that it is immoral, illegal (theft is a criminal offence) and unAustralian to permit one section of the population to steal with impunity from the great bulk of the population.

2. That Australia must separate legitimate commercial banking functions from the speculative activities of “investment banks”, as did the Glass-Steagall law in the United States so successfully from 1933 until its repeal in 1999. Such commercial banks serving the interests of the average Australian should be backed by the government, but the speculative banks should be left on their own to sink or swim—as do all commercial and professional entities in our society. In a Capitalist society, banks have no right to privileges that are clearly in the category of corporate welfare. Australian banks at present are bludgers in the community. My ground *for making this demand* is the broadly recognised moral tenet that it's treasonous and criminal to maintain a position of privilege that can only exist by:

(i) maintaining an ignorant public (through media control and Murstein's Law, which states basically that the more important the dissemination of the information is to the common good and national interest, the less likely it will see the light of day in the media);

(ii) sharp practices that destroy the democratic integrity of the nation (by intimidation of our representatives);

(iii) sharp practices that shift money from a defenceless unprivileged class in society to a privileged one (by the medieval and Victorian transfer of wealth from poor to rich); and

(iv) sharp practices that undermine and destroy the nation's economy (the excesses engaged in by the financial world since deregulation of the banks). The present system is more at home in the sort of society Hitler had in mind for us had he got his way. He lost the war but got his way anyway with our financial system, which couldn't be any worse.

3. That to anchor such a system of private commercial banks, Australia must also establish a national bank typified by our old Commonwealth Bank, where our government directs credit into the real physical economy of agriculture, manufacturing, and infrastructure projects which provide for the common good, including employment opportunities for all.

My grounds for making this demand are the solid conviction that the Commonwealth Bank was the greatest gift to the nation any politician could make, and it took an American to do it (King O'Malley) against vile opposition from political pygmies like Fisher and Hughes. That the bank was sacrificed by Hawke/Keating to appease the big private banks is the greatest scandal and insult served on the Australian people.

4. That re-regulation of banks be given the highest priority in the national interest. Putting the onus on the people like me to make suggestions on how decency might be achieved in the financial sector is a disgrace. For one thing, it's common practice to ignore it as presumption. For another, the facts of our reality are kept from the public by sycophantic media bosses. And yet another, it's the duty of government to have not only a watchdog but a corruption-free Social Justice Commission (say of rotating eminent persons) whose task it is to courageously identify gross social anomalies like our banking system. Where are they? I shouldn't have to make appeals for what should be already established if we have any pretensions of being half civilized. The present reality is symptomatic of barbarism, and those who profit from it neither care nor want to discuss it.

My grounds for this demand ought to be obvious to anyone reading it who retains any remnants of common decency. Open season on bank deposits has to be stopped if we want to arrest the descent into barbarism already in train.

5. Australia's banks are at grave risk from their reckless derivatives speculation, and from the precariously-balanced domestic property bubble which is the worst in the OECD. The government has to implement a Glass-Steagall separation of Australia's banking system, into deposit-taking retail banks strictly separated off from the risky investment banks embroiled in what he termed the "money game" of derivatives speculation.

My grounds for this demand also ought to be obvious to anyone reading it. This measure would protect Australian depositors from the risks they are presently exposed to through their banks. By keeping deposits away from being used for speculation, they would be available for normal lending into the real economy, including to the farming and manufacturing industries that provide Australia's economic strength. We need a new credit system that not only prevents marauders from wrecking our finance system but of providing the basis for our own development as a nation. That, apparently, has become a luxury we can no longer expect from our corrupt political class.

I'm not alone in this thinking. The following eminent Australians think likewise. Rather than take the lead from the mass of Australians who don't understand why they have contempt for banks, take the lead from those who do. I'm in distinguished company here, as the list of signatures testifies.

An Urgent Call for a New National Bank

We, the undersigned, are sick to death of the misery and destruction which economic rationalism has wreaked on this country since it was adopted beginning 1983 by the Hawke/Keating governments, and continued by the Howard governments. Except for a handful of the very wealthy, these policies have been a disaster for virtually all Australians, including local government bodies, trade unions, Aborigines, ethnic groups, immigrants, students and teachers, healthcare providers, the rural sector, small business, the poor, the unemployed, the aged and disabled, and many other average, struggling Australians. Known as "globalisation", these policies have also produced an international economic crisis, with potential dire consequences for Australia.

Therefore, we urgently *demand* that the Parliament begin immediate moves toward the near-term establishment of a new national bank, with the kind of broad-ranging powers necessary to bring our callous private banks into line, and to initiate a recovery of our industries, our agriculture, our environment, and of our social and physical infrastructure, in order to provide the chance for a happy, optimistic future for *all* Australians, of whatever creed, colour, or country of origin. Such was the dream of the

courageous founder of our original Commonwealth Bank, King O'Malley; it is now urgent that we make that dream a reality.
