Programs under the Sustainable Rural Water Use and Infrastructure Program	Description of Program
New South Wales Private Irrigation Infrastructure Operators Program — Round 2	A Commonwealth-led State Priority Project under the Agreement for Murray-Darling Basin Reform of July 2008. This Program is aimed at improving scheme efficiencies including channel configuration, channel upgrades, on-farm upgrades and rationalisation for NSW Irrigation Infrastructure Operators.
Commonwealth On Farm Irrigation Efficiency Program — Round 3	A Commonwealth-led on-farm program targeted at improving the efficiency and productivity of on-farm water use and management in the Lachlan and southern-connected Murray Darling Basin, and to assist communities to adjust to a future with less water.
Northern Victoria Irrigation Renewal Program — On Farm	Part of the NVIRP2 package which is a State Priority Project under the Agreement for Murray-Darling Basin Reform of July 2008. The NVIRP2 on-farm initiative is a three year project which will deliver farm irrigation system upgrades to the Goulburn Murray Irrigation District.
New South Wales — Sustaining the Basin Irrigated Farm Modernisation Program	A State Priority Project under the Agreement for Murray-Darling Basin Reform of July 2008. This NSW government led on farm program aims to increase the water use efficiency of irrigated agriculture in regulated catchments in the NSW Murray-Darling Basin.
