Treasury consultation on exposure draft Treasury Laws Amendment (Consumer Data Right) Bill 2018

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Treasury Laws Amendment (Consumer Data Right) Bill 2018 (Bill).

The Bill proposes to establish the overarching regulatory framework for the new Consumer Data Right (CDR). My understanding is the Bill will update existing Commonwealth consumer and privacy laws to introduce new CDR safeguards, and leverage existing regulatory agencies and consumer complaint handling and redress mechanisms.

I note the new regulatory framework will empower the ACCC to recognise an existing industry Ombudsman scheme like my office for CDR consumer complaints, in a similar way to which the OAIC can recognise industry Ombudsman schemes for privacy complaints.

I look forward to ongoing engagement with Treasury about the development of CDR for telecommunications services, and associated requirements for CDR complaints handling.
