

ACCOUNTABLE AUTHORITY INSTRUCTIONS

These Accountable Authority Instructions (AAIs) are issued under section 20A of the Public Governance, Performance and Accountability (PGPA) Act 2013 and give instruction to Treasury officials¹ on PGPA legislation.

These AAIs are the primary source of information and advice for officials on the internal financial management and procurement practices of the Department of the Treasury (Treasury) and have been promulgated to ensure the organisation complies with the financial legislation and associated policies affecting financial activities and sustainability. Non-compliance with the PGPA Act may be reportable and officials may incur sanctions under the Public Service Act 1999.

These AAIs are based on a model set of AAIs, issued by the Department of Finance. A Glossary of Terms is available on the intranet.

Financial delegations empower officials to execute their responsibility for specified financial tasks. Officials holding financial delegations are personally responsible and accountable for the decisions and actions taken when exercising their powers and are obliged to act in accordance with any issued directions.



Delegation of other PGPA powers, functions and duties

Delegation of other powers, functions and duties (under sections 23, 36, 45 and 60 of the PGPA Act; sections 11, 17 and 29 of the PGPA Rule; and sections 18, 19, 20 and 22 of the *Government Procurement (Judicial Review) Act 2018*) are hereby delegated, under PGPA Act section 110(1)(a) and, where relevant, under Direction 6.1(4) of the Finance Ministers Delegation, to the Deputy

AAI 2 - APPROVAL AND COMMITMENT OF RELEVANT MONEY

This AAI provides instruction to Treasury officials on approving and committing relevant money and entering into, varying or administering arrangements. It includes instructions in relation to:

- approving proposed commitments of relevant money and entering into arrangements;
- guarantees, indemnities, warranties and other contingent liabilities;
- official travel;
- · official hospitality; and
- · sponsorships.

AAI 2.2 - GUARANTEES, INDEMNITIES, AND WARRANTIES, ON BEHALF OF THE COMMONWEALTH

The Finance Minister has delegated to the Secretary the power to enter into an indemnity, guarantee or warranty on behalf of the Commonwealth. The delegation comes from section 60 of the PGPA Act and is subject to terms and conditions. The Secretary has delegated this power to the Deputy Secretary of Corporate Services and Business Strategy Group, who is able to sub-delegate it to Treasury officials. Refer to the Treasury Delegation instrument. The Finance Minister has not delegated the power to enter into loan guarantees.

Instructions - All officials

You cannot enter into an arrangement that includes the giving of an indemnity, guarantee or warranty, unless you have been delegated the power to grant an indemnity, guarantee or warranty on behalf of the Commonwealth (from an SES official).

You must comply with the directions in the authorisation when entering into an arrangement that involves an indemnity, guarantee or warranty.

Debt guarantees (including loan and equity guarantees) must be authorised by the Finance Minister.

You cannot enter into an arrangement that involves an indemnity, guarantee or warranty with another non-corporate Commonwealth entity.

Instructions - Delegates

You must comply with the directions set out in Schedule 1 Part 6 of the Finance Minister's Delegation.

Refer Operational Guideline 2.2 Guarantees, indemnities, warranties, on behalf of the Commonwealth for detailed procedural guidance to support this AAI.
