Hi I do bookkeeping for a couple of small businesses that are almost computer illiterate. I go to their office once a month, and have an exemption in place for stp reporting as they are incapable of running a payroll in MYOB. With one I have set up automatic pays in the bank, so everyone gets paid the same amount weekly, then I do any small adjustments for sick or holidays and lodge stp when I am there once a month. The other small business works out their pays manually on a timesheet using a paper copy of the tax tables, they text me the amounts and then I log into the bank and pay their staff from wherever I am working that day, and then I record it in MYOB once a month when I go to their office.

Will there be anything in place to enable some flexibility in paying super weekly? Neither of these businesses are capable enough to lodge and pay it themselves. They are older generation and petrified of doing the wrong thing on a computer.
