**CONSULTATION ON THE TREASURY LAWS AMENDMENT BILL 2024:  
PRODUCT SAFETY REGULATION (EXPOSURE DRAFT)**

**SUBMISSION FROM INFANT & NURSERY PRODUCTS ALLIANCE OF AUSTRALIA (INPAA)**

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Treasury Laws Amendment Bill 2024: Product Safety Regulation exposure draft. The short lead time to respond limits the depth of response but in principle INPAA supports the direction of the amended bill.

INPAA strongly supports the enabling uptake of current Australian Standards and overseas standards as mandatory where no Australian Standards exist, provided there is no trade-off in consumer safety.

This will be a major improvement, and we urge proceeding as soon as possible.

INPAA believes that effective consultation needs to be undertaken where international standards are to be adopted in Australia. Well understood processes used by Standards Australia provides a working model on how international standards can be adopted for Australia.
