2022/23 SUMMER OF CRICKET AND 2023/2024 FEDERAL BUDGET

As the summer of cricket draws to a close, I write on behalf of Cricket Australia to express our sincere thanks and gratitude for your support and that of the Australian Government for what has been a memorable and successful cricket season.

Cricket fans have been able to enjoy some amazing matches, including a record-breaking International Cricket Council Men's T20 World Cup, the most number of Women's and Men's international bilateral series that we have ever hosted in a single season, the return of national and state age and community championships across the country, including the National Inclusion Championships and National Indigenous Championships, along with the Weber Women's and KFC Men's BBL and other domestic competitions.

The successful staging of these matches has meant that over 1.8 million fans, both international and local, have been able to enjoy cricket in venues around the country, while many millions more have watched globally on television, online and through streaming services. This has ensured that the BBL remains the most-watched sporting league in Australia on a per-game basis.

The commitment of \$4.4 million in the Government's first budget for Cricket Australia's Multicultural Legacy Program is already having a significant impact off, continuing on the work done throughout the ICC Men's T20 World Cup played in Australia in October/November 2022.

We are working to progress several key projects and programs that align with our strategic plan, Where the Game Grows 2022-2027. 



As you are aware, Australian Cricket recently released *Where the Games* Grows, a five-year strategic plan for our sport. Its focus is to unite and inspire everyone to love and play cricket through a strong sustainable future with increased participation at all levels, particularly amongst girls and women, generating positive health and social impacts.

Under the plan, a strategic priority is investment in venues and facilities that enhance the experience for fans, players, officials, volunteers and communities alike making sure that cricket is accessible and welcoming for all.

Australian Cricket recognises that it is incumbent upon the national, state and territory cricket bodies to lead the investment in infrastructure and related programs to deliver the strategic outcomes identified in the plan. This investment also leverages the opportunity to co-invest with a range of partners to deliver amongst other things, policy outcomes and financial returns that can be reinvested back into the sport.

This has been evident over the past four years during which time Australian Cricket together with government, commercial and other partners have significantly invested in cricket infrastructure servicing local community cricket through to international-level facilities.

The partnership between Cricket Australia, state and territory associations and the Australian Cricketers' Association is a strong example of this through the commitment of funds for community cricket projects. Delivered through the *Australian Cricket Infrastructure Fund* combined with the players' *Grassroots Cricket Fund*, \$436 million in investment has been leveraged delivering over 900 projects nationally over the past four years.

A number of projects have received funding to assist with the recovery and rebuild of facilities in communities that have been severely impacted by natural disasters, particularly in Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria and South Australia.

In looking ahead, Australian Cricket is committed to increasing investment in cricket infrastructure while delivering a coordinated and sustainable national approach to this investment. This will include working with all levels of government as well as identifying other investment partnerships.

In doing so, we acknowledge and thank you and the Albanese Government for its various commitments to cricket as part of the 2022 Federal Election campaign. This included funding for cricket infrastructure projects in communities across the country of \$115 million with several key commitments made to flood recovery projects throughout Queensland and New South Wales to assist local cricket clubs recover from the significant damage incurred during the floods.

As we look to address these short-term imperatives as well as deliver our long-term strategic priorities, we are seeking to understand the Government's approach and related timeframes for the implementation of its election commitments.



Following another exciting and memorable summer of cricket, I write on behalf of Cricket Australia to express our sincere thanks and gratitude for the support extended by you and the Australian Government throughout the 2023-24 season.

The season featured record-breaking fan attendance across international fixtures and Big Bash League (BBL) matches, culminating in a 16 per cent year-on-year increase, totalling 1.6 million attendees. Notably, the Men's Test Match Series against Pakistan attracted 350,000 fans, while BBL matches recorded an average crowd uplift of 25 per cent.

The BBL maintained its position as the most-watched sports league per game, highlighting consistent growth in viewership across the various viewing platforms. Noteworthy is the threefold increase in audience engagement of Australian cricket content across India via Star Sports. Over 55 million fans watched the BBL season which was broadcast in multiple languages throughout India, underscoring the global appeal of our content and our sport.

At the community level, our Woolworths Cricket Blast program achieved unprecedented success, with a record 75,000 registrations, including a 25 per cent increase in female participation and a 30 per cent increase in children from multicultural communities.

We were proud to launch Australian Cricket's Multicultural Action Plan just prior to the Boxing Day Test Match to create further engagement and are incredibly pleased to see positive results in our grassroots programs as noted above. We were also excited to launch Australian Cricket's Women and Girls Action Plan this week to further accelerate the growth of women's cricket at all levels across Australia. We welcome the Australian Government's consideration of Cricket Australia's 2024-25 Federal Budget submission which details key investment opportunities contained within the Women and Girls Action Plan. Copies of both plans are attached.

Our social impact initiatives yielded significant results throughout the season. The Pink Test Match successfully raised over \$6.5 million for the McGrath Foundation, while the Shane Warne Legacy program facilitated crucial heart tests for 28,000 individuals, including over 7,500 people at the Boxing Day Test Match.

Looking ahead, our men's and women's national teams will compete in two pivotal International Cricket Council (ICC) events. In June 2024, our Men's team will vie for the ICC Men's T20 World Cup, while our Women's team will defend their title at the ICC Women's T20 World Cup in Bangladesh in September and October.

Anticipation also mounts for the upcoming summer of cricket, featuring marquee events such as the five-Test Match Men's Australia vs India Border-Gavaskar Trophy series and the Women's Australia vs England multiformat Ashes Series, including a day-night Test Match at the iconic Melbourne Cricket Ground. The match, being held from 30 January-2 February 2025, will mark the 90th anniversary of the first Women's Test Match that

featured the two countries and will be the first day-night Test Match ever played at the historic ground. Please find attached further information on the full list of international matches and locations for the 2024-25 summer of cricket. Invitations for matches throughout the season will be distributed later this year.



Re: Proposed ban on online advertising by Australian-licensed and regulated Online Wagering Service Providers

Responsible Wagering Australia (RWA) is the peak body representing the Australian licensed online wagering industry. Our members include Australia's major online wagering service providers (WSPs): bet365, Betfair, PointsBet, Sportsbet, and Unibet. RWA advocates for sensible and evidence-based regulations that promote consumer protections which do not result in unintended consequences such as driving consumers to illegal offshore providers. Our members are committed to maintaining high standards of safer gambling and other consumer protections.

I have appreciated the professional approach taken to industry consultation by Ministerial staffers and the bureaucracy regarding the proposed reforms to wagering advertising to date, but as we move closer to a decision from Government about the way forward, I ask that you hear from us directly, as the most heavily impacted industry and central stakeholder to this piece of reform.

I request a meeting with you to discuss these matters and their relevance and importance to your portfolio before a final decision is taken. I am of course happy to meet in a location suitable to you, and at your convenience.

Risks of overregulation are many, but as evidenced by the international experience, the largest one would be borne by Australian punters who will simply find the products they are looking for offshore if they aren't available *or visible* in Australia. The offshore market is already worth \$1.6 billion per annum (15 per cent of the total market) and growing. In this offshore environment, Australians are offered no protection, no personalised check-ins if unusual patterns of gambling occur, no offer of financial counselling support, no self-exclusion option, and no guarantee that they'll ever see a dollar of their money returned (win or lose).

Further, the integrity of sports and racing risk being compromised. Australian-licensed Wagering Service Providers routinely feed information about irregularities in wagering markets to both sports controlling bodies and racing authorities, often forming the basis of investigations. When consumers move into offshore markets, there are no efforts to verify people's identity and no traceability of funds (crypto) and risks are significantly amplified.

RWA supports a balanced regulatory approach that is considerate of the need to protect Australian punters. We would like to talk you through alternative strategies to achieve the Government's desired outcome of harm minimisation.

I look forward to hearing from your office in due course.
