## Sporting facilities

### **Women's changerooms at Sandringham Football Club**

Trevor Barker Beach Oval in the heart of Sandringham is a much-loved part of the local sporting landscape and is home to the Sandringham Zebras VFLW team. With the growth of women's sport, in particular Australian Football since the introduction of AFLW in 2017, the male change room facilities are outdated and inappropriate. There's only one open space for players to get changed in and one for umpires. Each space has one toilet cubicle, an open urinal and no private showers: just four shower heads side-by-side. Female players are getting changed in their cars.

The Club is seeking \$1.8 million from the Federal Government to upgrade its facilities. The priority is the North pavilion. The upgrade to the North pavilion will include two female-friendly change rooms, female-friendly umpire rooms and disability-friendly access. This project will benefit the broader community by providing an inclusive, welcoming, safe space that promotes gender equality.

The Club will contribute \$300,000 to the cost of the project, and the AFL has committed \$250,000. Bayside City Council, sponsors and members of the community are also in the funding mix.
