

## TO THE REGIONAL BANKING TASKFORCE

I am submitting my agreement that we should have a pure, sovereign Australian Bank linked to Australia Post.

I have 3 very good reasons for this agreement:

1. Our money remains in Australia. At the moment all Banks in Australia are owned by foreign corporations / bankers which means the full monetary wealth of the whole of Australia automatically and instantly goes overseas, none of it remains here.
2. When we have an Australian Bank, solely owned by the Australian People, then all wages, pensions, dividends, tax returns etc will be deposited into the relevant Australia Bank account. This means that the monies remain within Australia at all times unless the account holder wishes to transfer funds out and into an account in another bank.
3. As the monies remain in Australia, proper investments in infrastructure, industry, manufacturing can be made in Australia using these funds, thus eliminating the need to borrow funds from overseas banking giants. Returns from such investments will be greater for the account holders as overseas Banks will be eliminated. All returns go directly back to the Australia Bank account holders without the need for any returns to go to any overseas Bank.

However, it is absolutely essential that such an Australian Bank never be privatised or sold to an overseas corporate / bank by politicians, whether openly or secretly. This act was tried with Australia Post itself, to try to stop the creating of such a Bank of Australia. We know and understand that overseas corporations / banks do not want Australia to have its own national ' publicly owned Bank. We know and understand that overseas / foreign corporations and Banks want the wealth of Australians for themselves. We know that Australia is already completely in debt to foreign banks and corporations. We do not approve of this! We did not ask for this. We never agreed to this.

Politicians have sold Australia and the Australian People to foreign entities. This must be stopped.
