PLEASE EXCUSE THE HANDWRITTEN LETTER AS I do not own a computer or intend acquiring one. I am 62 years of age and have been retired from the workforce for a few years now. I am ready to sell my property and move to rural Queensland.

I have recently become aware that the four big bank since January 2020 to now December 2021 have closed in the vicinity of 350 branches Across AUSTRALIA. And while driving through regional Queensland, not only do I see less bank branches I have noticed ATM machines of major banks gone only to be replaced by teller machines where you have to pay to gain access to my own money.

I have also become aware that regional banks that are still operational in many regional towns have reduced their hours of opening from 9-30AM to 12-30pm in N.A.B and the Commonwealth BANK has reduced its hours from 9-30AM to 1-00pm.

WHERE does this leave the shopowners and small business that like to have

their money securely deposited of their days takings if banks ARE SHUTTING THEIR DOORS AT 12:30 AND 1:00 PM.

I believe that having POSTAL BANKING I am guaranteed services face to face where I can deal with a person which is my preference.

I also know that my money will be safe as Post Offices have the Government backing. Not so the private banking sector AS IF THEY INCUR HARDSHIPS THEY CAN "BAIL IN" WHICH ALLOWS THEM TO TAKE SOME OF MY MONEY TO PROPS THEMSELVES UP, WHICH I find ABHORENT.

AND IT IS MY BELIEF THAT HAVING A REGIONAL POST OFFICE BANKING SYSTEM EVEN THOUGH COMMERCIAL their surplus deposits can be reinvested back into local developments, and bank investments can circulate locally. Also any excess surplus investment can fund an infrastructure bank, which can help the Economic Development of Australia. WHERE AS PRIVATE BANKING INSTITUTIONS only serve their own interests AND NOT that of the community. THUS ALL THE BANK CLOSURES AND REMOVAL OF ATM'S that are happening of an alarming rate.
